WMVH – Bookings Summary 2023

The hall was reasonably well used during 2023 and at similar level to 2022 and generated slightly higher rental income. Unfortunately from a commercial point of view a large number of the bookings were from Worth groups for which we currently do not charge:-

Book Club

Film Club

Youth Club

CCT – Church Community Team

WCPT – Worth Community Property Trust

We also offered our facilities to the Church for various services while St Nicholas is closed for roof repairs.

We also did not charge when the National Trust were giving village briefings held at the VH when requested by residents.

We did however pick up some new clients during 2023 including Purbeck Farmers and Dorset AONB. We were once again used for Life Drawing on a regular basis and PASH took over the hall as usual during July/August and Nov/Dec. The VH was again used as part of the Purbeck Film Festival.

There were a number of parties/gatherings held at the hall both by residents and non-residents although in 2023 there were no weddings.

The Parish Council also returned to the village hall in November and are continuing to use the hall in 2024 on a bi-monthly basis.
